

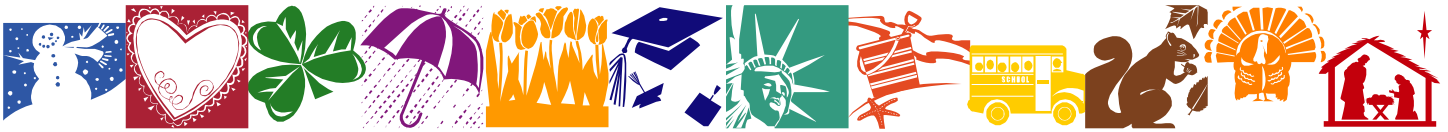

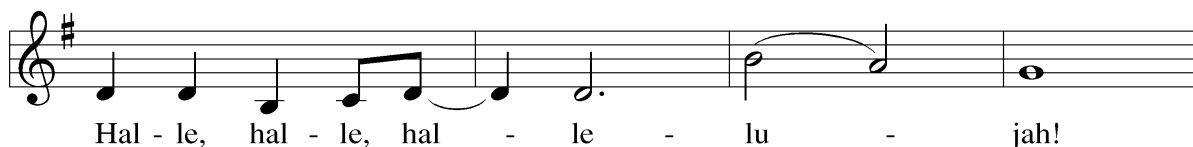

5. The house is on the right up on a hill. There is parking at the top.
